

4K Expansion Grant

We just received the notification that OLP was awarded a \$30,000 4K expansion grant!!!

These funds will pay for:



- site development plans for the outdoor play area
- repair flooring (water damage by sink) in the new 4K room (current 2nd grade room)
- placement of an individual water heater under the sink (DSS 4K requirement)
- additional funding for actions towards the completion of the outdoor play area.

Annex Expansion

Reasoning

we have grown every year for the last 5 years. We are currently at over 180 students and we have had waiting lists for multiple grade levels the last two years. We have exceeded our 1:20 teacher:student ratio and as a result have hired permanent aides in 4K - 2nd grade. We have altered the school as much as we possibly can to accommodate our growing numbers. We have to expand if we wish to continue our growth.

What does it involve?

We plan to renovate 4 out of the 8 classrooms along with the student bathrooms this school year (depending on cost increases). ELA, Social Studies, Math, & Religion will be located in those 4 classrooms. MS will have to walk back to the elementary building for some specials and science. The plan is to eventually renovate the old science lab (room 1) and the other three classrooms to relocate the whole MS faculty and all the student classes down the hill.

Annex Expansion

Impact on Elementary School

We plan to begin another 4K classroom with 10 students the first year and grow to a two classroom 4K center with 20 students in each classroom by year 2.

We plan to hire a 5th grade teacher so we can place 5th grade back into elementary school

2nd grade - 5th grade will be moved to the current middle school hallway

A STEM Science lab/room will be established in the current 3rd grade classroom

Spanish will be placed in the current 4th grade classroom

What's Going on at OLP? School Choice

School Choice was passed this past summer and will be implemented next school year 2024 - 2025 SY. It is an EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT/PLAN.

Funds are deposited into a secure online account and transferred to the school of their choice for tuition and fees.

- 24 25 SY5,000 students receive up to \$6,000 of tuition & fees200% of federal poverty level guidelines
- 25 26 SY 10,000 students receive up to \$6,000 of tuition & fees 300% of federal poverty level guidelines
- 26 27 SY 15,000 students receive up to \$6,000 of tuition & fees 400% of federal poverty level guidelines

What we know about it so far...



- 1st year of the program only 1st year kindergartners and public school students are eligible.
- Application window will be between January 15, 2024 March 15, 2024.
- A rolling acceptance/awards once funds are gone, they are gone for the year
- \$6,000 to be applied to private school tuition and fees (other alternatives as well; homeschool is not an option); anticipating an increase for inflation each year
- 200% of federal poverty level with it increasing 100% each year

NEW INFORMATION (more info to come on all of the below)

- Undocumented families are eligible to apply and accept the award
- 1st Steps qualified 4K students will automatically qualify, if they apply
- Any student on Medicare will automatically qualify, if they apply
- No state in recent history has meet their cap of applicants.
- Diocese will be pushing hard beginning in January to include current students

Mass Behavior Reminder
